American Board of certified in both Obstetrics and Gynecology & Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery certified, and 2. have 5-7 years of experience in an academic environment and 5-7 years clinical experience.

Professor rank must meet the REQUIRED PROFESSIONAL LICENSE OR CERTIFICATES prior to the start date of employment and also be. American Board of certified in both Obstetrics and Gynecology & Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery certified, and 2. have 7 or more years of experience in an academic environment and 7 or more years clinical experience.
